Fraudsters are targeting seniors by calling and pretending to be a family member in distress. the police or a justice official claiming that a loved one or grandchild is in trouble, and needs money immediately. Victims are told there's a gag order, and can't speak to anyone.

Call demanding immediate payment for bail, or fines to avoid going to jail

Remember! The courts won't ask for cash to bail out someone in custody, and will require people to be present in court.



Claim to be a lawyer, police or family member in an emergency situation demanding funds

Be suspicious of calls that require immediate action. Hang up! Call your local police and contact the family member directly.



Request cash and send couriers for pick up, or demand the victim send cash by courier services or via cryptocurrency

Never send cash, cryptocurrencies or any other funds to unknown persons, unverified addresses or bank accounts.

It was a Beautiful September Day for a Walk!

Thank you Lasalle Secondary School and Greater Sudbury Police Service along with special guests who participated to walk and bring greetings and encouragement to the students for their efforts in raising awareness and supporting active living for seniors who call Finlandia Village their home at the 6th annual Sling Choker SISU Family Walk held on Saturday September 16, 2023.

This year's fundraiser – which included door-to-door canvassing, the annual SISU Family Walk, a silent auction, and donations from family, friends and Finlandia staff – raised \$17,000 to support fitness and wellness for resident at Finlandia Village.

Some 300 people gathered on September 16th for the seven-kilometre walk from the school in New Sudbury to Finlandia Village in Minnow Lake. Upon arrival, walkers were greeted by the Greater Sudbury Police Pipe Band followed by a delicious lunch at the Hall.

"I am simply amazed by the generosity of our students, families and community," says Lasalle Secondary School Principal Kristina Rivard Gobbo. "Through this collective effort, our students have demonstrated the importance of building community - one of the values modelled and taught in Rainbow Schools."

Staff and students have become a driving force behind this fundraiser. To date, more than \$145,000 has been raised for fitness equipment, outdoor trails and signage, as well as a gardening project at the Village.

Donations will continue to support outdoor walking trails and equipment. A fully accessible trail system, which winds its way around the property, is developed and partially built. A portion is also signed. Future work will include self-directed exercise stops and more outdoor equipment to enhance the physical benefits of exercise while walking the trails.

"I extend heartfelt thanks to members of the community who continue to support this important work," says Principal Rivard Gobbo. "We sincerely appreciate every dollar donated, as our students work to promote active living at all stages of life."

She adds: "We are incredibly honoured to give back to a community that has given so much to us – a community we are proud to call home. Kiitos!"

Finlandia Village has enjoyed a long-standing partnership with Lasalle Secondary School. The partnership began in 2007 with the launch of the Intergenerational Memoirs Writing Program. The program fosters co-operation, collaboration, understanding, positive interactions and fellowship opportunities for students, while bridging the gap between generations.

Cycling Around the Globe with Motiview

Motiview is a technology developed in Norway that enables people to go on virtual cycling trips. The Finlandia Fitness Centre and Hoivakoti gym are equipped with a stationary bicycle and a treadmill that are paired with software on our Smart TV's that contains a library of videos of locations around the world. While you cycle, the video moves the person through the various locations. As well, there are two Sudbury Routes trails featured, Bell Park and Lake Laurentian Conservation.

Each year, Motiview hosts the Road Worlds for Seniors which is a virtual sporting event and is the only global indoor championship for Seniors and people with dementia. Every year, thousands of cyclists from Nursing Homes, Day Care Centers and Seniors' centers participate.

The Road Worlds for Seniors challenge took place from October 2nd to 27th, 2023, and Finlandia Village participated with two teams at eight members per team. The "Finlandia Steppers" who trained in the Fitness Centre along with the "Finlandia Spinners" in Hoivakoti, cycled their way through various trails and streets around the world, and they had AMAZING results...

- Finlandia Steppers logged 243.3 km traveled
- Finlandia Spinners logged 123.6 km traveled...

HEALTHY RECIPE CORNER Sweet Potato Pie

INGREDIENTS

- 1/3 cup of soft butter or margarine
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 2 eggs, lightly beaten
- 3/4 cup evaporated milk
- 2 cups mashed sweet potato
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1/2 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp ground nutmeg
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 9 inch unbaked pie shell

PREPARATION

- Preheat oven to 425°F
- 2. In a mixing bowl, cream butter and sugar.
- 3. Add eggs and mix well.
- 4. Add milk, sweet potatoes, vanilla and salt. Mix well.
- 5. Pour mixture into the pie shell
- 6. Bake at 425°F for 15 minutes.
- 7. Reduce heat to 350°F and bake for an additional 30—45 minutes.

Joulukertomus



Viime joulun alla siskolta tuli vastustamaton ehdotus: "Tule jouluksi Helsinkiin!" Siispä kapusin kiskobussiin lumisessa Pohjois-Karjalassa. Joensuusta etelään matkaavassa junassa oli hyvin tilaa, kun muu kansa vaelsi enimmäkseen päinvastaiseen suuntaan. Kiskojen kolkkeessa oli aikaa lähetellä joulutervehdyksiä ystäville ja ottaa muutamat nokoset.

Helsingissä nurmi vihannoi ja minun sydämessäni liikuskeli joulu. Siellä se pesii ympäri vuoden, mutta vuoden lopulla se kasvaa isoimmaksi ja on aktiivisimmillaan.

Ehkä etsin joltakulta tuttavalta lainaksi toiset kunnon pitkät ja leveät sivakat siltä varalta, että sisko pystyisikin saapumaan jouluseurakseni Pohjois-Karjalaan. Salolla on varmasti sen verran lunta, että pääsemme jouluhiihdolle.
