Code Orange- Community Disaster. The City of Sudbury establishes the framework to ensure the City is prepared to deal with any hazards. It is the methodology through which the City will mobilize its resources in the event of an emergency, thereby restoring the municipality to a state of normalcy. Purpose is to provide guiding principles for protecting the health, safety, and welfare of the residents when faced with an emergency

POLICY STATEMENT

The following emergency disaster that can occur within the City of Greater Sudbury may include but not limited to:

- **Community evacuations**
- **Health-related emergencies**
- **Hazardous material releases**
- **Drinking water source protection emergencies**
- **Transportation emergencies**
- **Sever weather emergencies**
